

Numeracy & Mathematics

Numeracy & Mathematics equips us with the skills we need to interpret and analyse information, simplify and solve problems, assess risk and make informed decisions.

Children are taught within the guidelines comprising:-

- 1. NUMBER, MONEY and MEASURE**
- 2. SHAPE POSITION and MOVEMENT**
- 3. INFORMATION HANDLING**

The maths programme usually begins with 15 – 20 minutes oral/mental maths. Children work at a level and pace appropriate to their abilities, and when they have completed concepts receive regular summative and formative assessment.

Where possible pupils practice their skills in real life contexts.

As part of Glasgow Improvement Challenge we have Numeracy Challenge Leaders of Learning supporting targeted pupils in Numeracy & Mathematics for 0.8 each week.
