
## Grammar: Full Stops and Commas

### Mathematics: Angles and Symmetry

L.I: To identify different angles in our environment. **Please listen to my recorded lesson posted on Seesaw!** We are going to recap our knowledge of angles. An angle is a measure of a turn and is written in degrees or you might see a ° next to a number. For example, 360° <u>These are the angles we have:</u>

Right angle: 90° Obtuse angle: Between 90° and 180° Acute angle: Less than 90°

Reflex angle: More than 180°

Task I: Complete the Seesaw activity on labelling angles. Task 2: Can you find any of these angles in your home or outside? Take some pictures and draw the angle to show me. Don't forget to upload the pictures to Seesaw! Extension: Complete the two BBC clips activities from the same link above.

#### Religious Education:
