DINNER SCHOOL

For those not in receipt of Free Meals

families should use Parent Pay to pay for their child's meals. Parents can order meals in advance through Parent Pay. Alternatively, pupils select choices on a daily basis at registration. All children in P1-P5 do not pay for school meals.

BREAKFAST CLUB 8-8:45AM

The charge for breakfast is £2 but additional children in the family pay £1 per day. Money will be collected through Parent Pay. Pupils entitled to a



free school meal will receive breakfast for free. Please note if your child is attending our Breakfast Club, they must be registered by 8:15am for health and safety reasons. Children should enter via the front door. Again, we cannot permit parents to accompany their child into the school building. Children should NOT arrive before 8am as there is no catering staff to supervise before then. Children will be supervised in the playground from 8:45am onwards.

The forms should be returned to Glasgow City Council, Grants Section, PO Box 26816, Glasgow G2 **9AF**.

Forms can also be handed in to the Service Desk at 45 John Street, however no forms should be posted to John Street.

All existing applicants have already been sent a declaration form – if there have been no changes in your circumstances from last year, the declaration form should be completed and returned to the address above. If your circumstances have changed (i.e. change of

name/address/employment status), you should complete a new application form. Likewise, if you have misplaced your declaration or not received one in the post, a new application form should be completed.

LABELS

Please ensure all your child's belongings are labelled. We always have a huge collection of lost property that we cannot return to owners.



Although as a school we endeavour to assist the children with looking after their belongings, please note it is not the school's responsibility if items go missing.

We strive to provide a safe learning environment for all our pupils.



We have a growing number of pupils who have allergies to specific foods and due to this we are a **NUT AWARE SCHOOL**. We are asking all members of the school community for their help in minimising the risk to these children by:

a) Avoiding giving children nuts or nut products in their packed lunches (Please note that some chocolate spread contains nuts).

b) Avoiding giving nuts or nut products or snacks/bars containing nuts for break time snacks.c) Avoiding supplying the school with cakes or food items containing nuts for sales or events.

d) Avoiding sending containers such as cereal boxes for Design & Technology / Art lessons into school which may have contained produce made with nuts.
