In order to ensure the safety of our pupils we remind parents that the **drop off area in front of the school is for school use only** and is to provide safe access for the transportation of our pupils who attend our Language and Communication Resource. Gates to the school grounds will be locked at 9.15am until 2.45pm. This is to prevent unknown adults being in the school grounds during the school day.

PLAYGROUND ARRANGEMENTS

P1 - One adult is permitted for morning drop off and for pick up at 3pm (if escorting a P1 child in the mornings, adults should please remain in the P1 playground and not in the middle playground.)

P2 and **P3** pupils should enter the playground independently (9am) from Monday 19th August. **One adult** is permitted at dismissal time (3pm) for P2, P2/3 and P3 pupils.

P4-P7 pupils should enter and leave the playground independently. Those families who have asked for special permission to accompany their child, please call at the school office to apply for a playground pass.

NO DOGS

As per GCC policy, no dogs are permitted in our playground at any time.



GYM KIT

Children may wear gym kit to school on PE days as part of our updated uniform policy. Our uniform supplier ASPIRE is selling jogging trousers, shorts and T Shirts. Please note, football/badged items are not permitted to be worn for PE. We ask that children wear appropriate colours such as black/white/purple on gym days. A change of shoes is required for indoor P.E. P.E days and times will be communicated by your child's class teacher.



TOYS

Pupils must **not** bring toys to school, as if lost or broken it is not the school's responsibility to replace.



Pupils are encouraged to wear school uniform every day. There may be occasions where pupils are encouraged to dress to support a charity fundraiser or for a sporting event. Families will be notified of this in advance.

DINNER SCHOOL

For those not in receipt of Free Meals families of P6 and P7 pupils should use Parent Pay to pay for their child's meals. Parents can order meals in advance through Parent Pay. Alternatively, pupils select choices on a daily basis at registration. **All children in P1-P5 do not pay for school meals.**



BREAKFAST CLUB 8-8:45AM

The charge for breakfast is £2 but additional children in the family pay £1 per day. Money will be collected through Parent Pay. Pupils entitled to a free school meal will receive breakfast for free.

Please note if your child is attending our Breakfast Club, they **must** be registered by **8:15am** for health and safety reasons.

Children should enter via the front door.

Again, we cannot permit parents to accompany their child into the school building. Children should **NOT** arrive before 8am as there is no catering staff to supervise before then. Children will be supervised in the playground from 8:45am onwards.



CLOTHING GRANTS/FREE MEAL ENTITLEMENT



Please note the forms are available on the Glasgow website www.glasgow.gov.uk if eligible. (* Please note, filling the forms on line is the quickest method)

The forms should be returned to **Glasgow City Council, Grants Section, PO Box 26816, Glasgow G2 9AF.**

Forms can also be handed in to the Service Desk at 45 John Street, however no forms should be posted to John Street.

All existing applicants have already been sent a declaration form – if there have been no changes in your circumstances from last year, the declaration form should be completed and returned to the address above. If your circumstances have changed (i.e. change of name/address/employment status), you should complete a new application form. Likewise, if you have misplaced your declaration or not received one in the post, a new application form should be completed.

ABSENCES FROM SCHOOL

A reminder of procedures regarding reporting of absence. Families do not contact the school to inform of absence. **Families are to use the absence reporting line on 0141 287 0039.** If you do not wish to be contacted via text message, please inform the school office. Text messaging is also very useful when keeping parents informed and up-to-date with school events and activities.

NUT AWARE SCHOOL

We strive to provide a safe learning environment for all our pupils.

We have a growing number of pupils who have allergies to specific foods and due to this we are a **NUT AWARE SCHOOL**. We are asking all members of the school community for their help in minimising the risk to these children by:

- Avoiding giving children nuts or nut products in their packed lunches (Please note that some chocolate spread contains nuts).
- Avoiding giving nuts or nut products or snacks/bars containing nuts for break time snacks.
- Avoiding supplying the school with cakes or food items containing nuts for sales or events.
- Avoiding sending containers such as cereal boxes for Design & Technology / Art lessons into school which may have contained produce made with nuts.
