Reading- In Class Nevis we will be reading everyday a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. We develop our knowledge and understanding of the text through reading comprehension tasks.

Talking and Listening- We will be developing our talking and listening skills through our IDL topic and by sharing our weekly news.

Spelling - Every day, spelling exercises will be conducted through written, sensory and active activities.

Writing- This term, our writing focus will be on report and explanation writing linked to our natural disasters' topic. We will be carrying out short handwriting activities to develop our letter formation.



This term we will be focusing on place value, counting and numerals. We will carry out a range of practical lessons to further develop knowledge and understanding.

In Mathematics we will be concentrating the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and pattern.

As we return to school we will be focusing on the school values this term, making our class charter and building new relationships with teachers and peers. We will be further developing our understanding of emotions and how to express them adequately.



PE: Our PE days are a Monday (indoors).



On a Monday the children will receive a new reading book. Children should be encouraged to read the book at home or be read too. School books to be returned on the Friday.
Common words will be sent home weekly to practice through a variety of ways.



Social Studies/ Science/ Technology- our Topic is Natural Disasters we will be exploring different types of disasters each week.

Expressive arts- This is linked with our topic.

Outdoor Learning- We will be carrying out outdoor learning through our class topic and numeracy.

Digital Literacy- We will be learning about online safety and using different search engines and online resources to research different natural disasters.
