



# P2 Class Information

**BLOCK 1**  
**2025-26**



**Reading-** In reading Primary 2 will be developing their ability to read aloud with increasing fluency and expression. We will be focussing on common words and developing their knowledge of phonics to support this.

**Talking and Listening-** Children will listen to stories and give feedback on what they have heard. They will develop skills in turn taking during talking and listening.

**Spelling-** Primary 2 will take part in daily active spelling activities. They will be encouraged to spell words independently using their knowledge of phonics.

**Writing-** In writing, Primary 2 will be exploring recount and procedural writing in a range of contexts. They will recount a variety of activities in school and out through 'Have a Go' writing as well as other aspects. With a big focus on capitals and full stops.

**French** - We will begin to embed French into our daily routines such as greetings, days of the week and the weather.



In numeracy, children will be exploring number bonds to 20 and place value. They will be able to recognise, order numbers and add numbers to 20. We will also be rounding to the nearest 10.

In Maths, Primary 2 will explore time. They will be learning to order days of the week, months of the year and seasons. We will also be learning about money and shape.

**H&WB:** Our focus for this block is Values and Emotions. Children will be exploring the School Values, RESPECT and the Sandwood Voyagers. We will explore different emotions and learn how express how we feel. We will be in the rainbow garden on a Wednesday afternoon.

**PE:** P,E will take place on Thursday (MUGA) and Monday (Gym Hall). Please ensure children wear suitable footwear and clothing for all weather types when outside. As per GCC Health & Safety Physical Education guidelines, pupils **cannot** have jewellery or earrings in.



Homework will be issued on a **Tuesday** to be completed by the following **Monday**. This will allow families time to work on homework activities over the weekend. We suggest that no more than 10 - 15 minutes is spent on homework each night. Children will be given a reading book on **Tuesday**, this should also be returned the following **Monday**. Written activities, such as spelling, will be given out for children to complete.

**We are currently in the process of reviewing our homework policy. More information to follow.**



For **Social Studies/Science/Technology, Expressive Arts** and **Stem** we will have a whole school focus on Glorious Glasgow for the 850<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

**RME** We will be learning about the book of Ruth from the Judaism faith and Harvest from the Christian faith.
