



Class Clyde Information

BLOCK 1

Reading- In Class Clyde, we will be focusing on our daily circle times which will include nursery rhymes, songs and stories, with Makaton used alongside spoken language to support children's communication skills. In the afternoons, we will enjoy 'Fruit and a Book', exploring sensory books with different textures and materials. These sessions will encourage children to listen, communicate, explore and develop a love of books and stories

Talking and Listening- We are learning to follow class routines and instructions. Each week, children will be introduced to a Core Word of the Week, which we will explore through fun and engaging activities to support their communication, understanding and confidence.

Phonics/Spelling - Children will be introduced to phonics this term, focusing on the letters SATPIN. Daily activities will be carried out to help children recognise, explore and develop an awareness of sounds and letters through fun and engaging activities.

Writing- We will be developing our fine motor skills through a range of funky fingers and mark making opportunities.

NUMERACY



Numeracy- We will be introducing numbers up to 5 this term. We will be using a range of songs and fun engaging activities for the children to explore and develop their understanding of numbers.

Mathematics- We will be exploring patterns and relationships this term, focusing on finding familiar items that go together or match through fun, hands-on activities and everyday experiences.

HWB: Within Class Clyde, we will be learning about our school day, daily routines and how we can work, play and take care of our classroom together.



PE: In the afternoon we will be carrying out daily gross motor activities, children will carry out sensory circuits within the classroom focusing on alerting, organising and calming activities helping to get ready for the afternoon.



IDL -Topic

This term, our focus will be communication and understanding. Children will be introduced to a Core Word of the Week, alongside choosing boards, Now and Next boards and daily visual timetables. These supports will help children to communicate their needs and choices, understand classroom routines and develop greater independence and confidence throughout the school day.



Outdoor learning: Children will have opportunities to develop their social skills and build new friendships across the LCR during outdoor play. They will be encouraged to interact with others, take turns and develop positive relationships.

Bucket time: This activity will take place daily during our afternoon sessions, providing children with opportunities to develop their social interactions and communication skills through a range of fun, messy and engaging activities.
