Reading- This term in Clyde we will be listening and singing along to nursery rhymes and listening to stories during fruit and a book.

Listening and Talking - We are learning to follow instructions using our objects of reference and visual cards.

Writing - We will be developing our fine motor skills to get our fingers ready to hold pencils and pens through different funky finger activities and mark making opportunities.



Numeracy - We will be introduced to numbers within 5 through our nursery rhymes, simple songs and counting activities.

Maths - During our maths sessions will be learning to sort objects by different criteria.



PE - We will be carrying out daily Gross motor skills activities in the classroom, such as balancing, rolling and jumping.

HWB - We are learning our new school routine and learning how to work, play and take care of our classroom.



IDL - Topic

This term for our topic we will be Nursery Rhymes! We are going to be learning Makaton to our favourite nursery rhymes and explore them through sensory play, puppets and musical instruments.



Outdoor Learning - We will be developing our social skills in the garden with our new friends.

Bucket Time - Bucket time is an engaging session to assist children with increasing their engagement and concentration by introducing them to fun and exciting sensory toys.
