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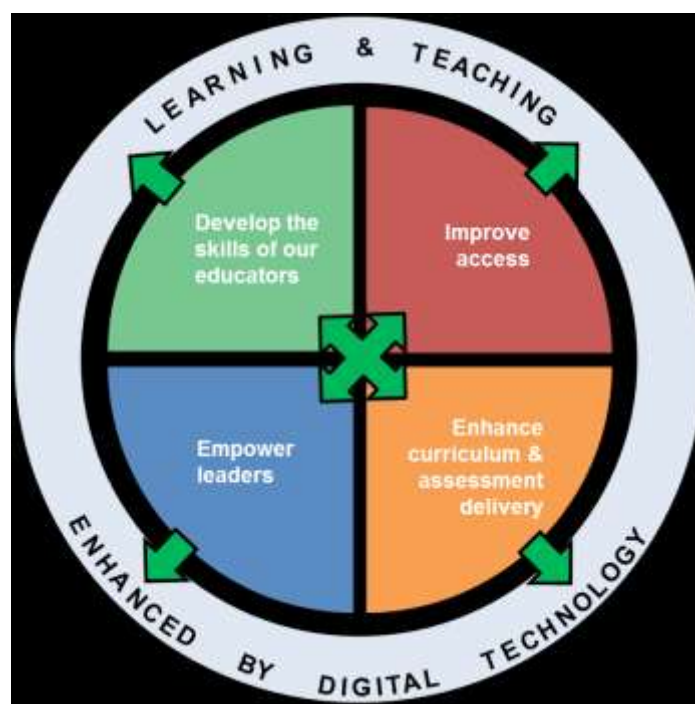

- ✓ Support visits with a primary focus on Digital Technologies to enhance teaching and learning experiences will be incorporated into the school calendar of monitoring and tracking
- ✓ All PRDS will include developments in aspects of Digital Learning and the in house CLPL calendar will be tailored around agreed aspects of development
