This means adjectives. You pronounce it "lays ajekteef"

This week we're using adjectives to describe ourselves and others. Listen to me pronounce the adjectives on this link and go on to Languagenut for further practice.

petit (small, short)

grand (tall)

de taille moyenne (medium height)



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Il est grand.

What does this mean?

Yes- he is tall.



Elle est grande.

What does this mean?

Yes- she is tall.

What do you notice about the word *grand*?

Yes- when it is elle est (she is) the grand ends in e.
