Reading – In class Lomond, we enjoy reading every day. We read a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts and have good discussions about them. Class story is one of our favourite times of the day when we all relax and come together to enjoy a story.

Listening and Talking – We focus on our talking and listening skills through organised activities as well as through daily opportunities for learning and developing our skills in and around the classroom.

Writing – This term our writing focus will be explanation and persuasive writing. Our writing will link with much of our topic work and interests of the children. We continue to complete weekly news and handwriting too.

Spelling – We do spelling every day in Lomond class. We enjoy learning and practising our weekly spelling words in a variety of active and sensory ways. This term, we will also be focusing on learning to spell some of the common words that we find tricky to spell.



This term in maths, we will be focusing on division.

We will also complete a unit of work on fractions and decimals.

The children will enjoy fun and interactive resources and strategies to help them access their learning in maths.



In class Lomond, we have a continual focus on emotions as part of our HWB programme and daily routine.

This term, we will also have sessions focusing on choices and change.

PE – please ensure your child has their gym kit, bring to school on a Monday and take home on a Friday.



Each Monday, children will bring home a new reading book for the week. The aim is that children should read, or be read to, at home 3 times per week.

Social Studies/Science/Technology We are doing a range of short topics this term linked to our own interests – leading our own learning.

Expressive Arts Much of our art, music, PE and drama will be cross-curricular, linked to our topic.

RME This term, we will be learning and thinking about 'Growing up in Jesus' Time.'

Outdoor Learning We will carry out a variety of outdoor learning experiences across the curriculum

Digital Literacy We will be developing our use of online communication.

STEM – we will look at a variety of STEM challenges linked to our topic.

Uniform – make sure all items of uniform are labelled.
