# Phonics



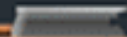
- We teach the letter sound, name and song.

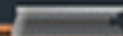

### LITERACY

**Reading**- Words from Stage 1 Storyworld books will be issued in homework folders. Please go over these regularly with your child to ensure they are familiarised with these before reading books are issued in the coming weeks.  
**Talking and Listening**- We will be developing our talking and listening skills every Monday morning through sharing our weekend news. Children will be encouraged to take turns, listen to others and respond appropriately.  
**Phonics** - This block we will be using the Jolly Phonics programme to introduce 2 letter sounds per week. We will use a song, story and action, which will provide a multisensory learning experience for the children. As new sounds are taught these will be sent home on flashcards to practise at home, the songs can also be found on YouTube should you wish to sing these with your child.  
**Writing**- We will be developing our fine motor skills and pincer grip through our finger exercise programme. This will help to strengthen fingers, develop pencil control and help children to form letters correctly.  
**French** - In French we will be using songs, games and rhymes to learn French greetings and how to introduce ourselves.

### NUMERACY Maths

In Numeracy, Primary 1 will be learning to recognise, write and order numbers. We will practise counting forwards and backwards from different starting points. We will also be learning to count on to solve addition problems. We will also be identifying, naming and sorting 2D shapes and using them to create repeated patterns.

**H&WB**: Our focus for this block is Values and Emotions. Children will be exploring the School Value, RESPECT and the Sandwood Voyagers. We will explore different emotions and learn how express how we feel.



**PE**: PE will take place on Thursday afternoons in the gym hall. We will be learning about following instructions in command games and learning how to keep our bodies fit and healthy. Children may come to school wearing gym clothes on this day.

### Homework

We are working on providing homework through SeeSaw and Sumdog this session. Information on how to set this up for your child has been issued, please approach Mrs Flanagan or Mrs Devine if you need any help. Homework will be issued on a Tuesday to be completed by the following Monday. This will allow families time to work on homework activities over the weekend. We suggest that no more than 10 - 15 minutes is spent on homework on each night you choose to complete it.

### Across the Curriculum

Learning through play is an integral tool in Primary 1 which allows us to provide the children with the chance to participate in varied learning opportunities. All curricular areas will be delivered through play, with literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing being a part of all activities in the classroom and permeating throughout all learning. Our IDL focuses this term will be People Who Help Us and Fairyland.
