# Our Class

As we are a composite, we can have no more than 25 children in our class.

We use the Rainbow Garden once a week for outdoor learning.

P.E. - We have indoor P.E. on a Tuesday in the gymhall and outside in the MUGA on a Thursday.

Lunch: It is preferable for families to order online with your child at home however Class Teachers will order with children who have been unable to do so. Lunches are free for P1-5.

#### Literacy

- Reading: All children will have a reading book that they can read in class and take home. These books are at their reading level.
- Writing: VCOP, Daily Handwriting.
- Talking and Listening: Lessons linked to other areas of the curriculum as well as stand alone.
- Spelling/Phonics: Children in a group that suits their level.
- Common Words: Children in a group that suits their level.

#### **Maths and Numeracy**

- Numeracy- different concepts will be covered each term.
- Mental Maths- Daily counting and mental maths problems.
- Active maths- children will develop and make use of mathematical skills whilst engaging in stimulating play, physical activity, and ICT.
- Outdoor learning- Over the term, children get handson and will explore maths and numeracy outside.

We encourage families to practice numeracy at home, by completing Seesaw tasks, practicing skip counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s, and working on the correct formation

#### P2/3 Class Information

BLOCK 1 2023-24



Reading- In reading, Primary 2/3 will be developing their ability to read aloud with increasing fluency and expression. We will be using a variety of strategies to support reading such as predicting, visualising, and retelling. We will also be reading and writing common words daily and learning new sounds each week to support reading.

Talking and Listening-Children will listen to stories and give feedback on what they have heard. They will develop skills in turn-teking during talking and listening. Spelling-Primary 2/3 will take part in daily active spelling activities. They will be encouraged to spell words independently using their knowledge of phonics. Writing- In writing, Primary 2/3 will explore recount and procedural writing in various centexts. They will recount their weekend through ness writing as well as other aspects. This will allow pupils to develop their basic writing skills such as cepital letters, full stops, and finger spaces.

French - We will begin to embed French into our doily routines such as greetings, days of the week and the weather. Further to this we will explore fruits.



We are working on providing homework through See Saw, this session.

Homework will be issued on a Tuesday to be completed by the following Monday. This will allow families time to work on homework activities over the weekend, We suggest that no more than 10 - 15 minutes is spent on homework each night. Children's will be given a reading book on Tuesday, this should also be returned the following Monday.





In numeracy, children will be exploring number bonds to 100 and place value. They will be able to recognise, form and order numbers. We will also be learning to add within numbers to 100 and rounding to the nearest 10.

In Maths, Primary 2/3 will explore time. They will be learning to order days of the week, months of the year and seasons. We will also be learning about money and shape.

HAWB: Our focus for this block is Values and Emotions. Children will be exploring the School Values, RESPECT and the Sandwood Voyagers. We will explore different emotions and learn how express how we feet.

PE: PE will take place on Tuesday (6ym hall) and Thursday (Muga). Please ensure children weer suitable footwear and clothing for all weather types when outside. As per 6CC Health & Safety Physical Education audelines, puells cannot have jewellery or earrings in.



Social Studies/Science/Technology: Our focus this block is on Knights and Castles.

Expressive Arts: Children will learn about different skills through our class topic of Knights and Castles. RME: We will be learning about Old Testament Stories and

Outdoor Learning: We will carry out a variety of outdoor learning experiences across the curriculum.

Harvest Festival from the Christian faith.

Digital Literacy: We will use iPads in class and Sundag and See Saw, at home for homework tasks.
