Literacy and Language

Reading- Class Nevis takes part in reading and comprehension activities every day. As well as our levelled reading books we enjoy taking time for personal reading and story time to encourage the habit and enjoyment of reading.

Talking and Listening- We work on our talking and listening skills throughout the day, across all curricular areas. We also take time during our 'Social Time' and 'Daily Mile' sessions to discuss our daily news and ask questions to each other. Writing – This term we will focus on poetry and setting and we will explore these contexts through our China topic work.

Spelling- We continue with our daily spelling practice and pupils enjoy taking part in various active spelling activities, particularly the messy ones!



Pupils will normally be given a new reading book at the beginning of each week. The aim is that children should read, or be read to, at home 3 times per week and this should be recorded in the home/ school communication sheet.


Other Curricular Areas
