Reading: The children will participate in book clubs to support each other to develop their reading skills. They are welcome to bring their own books to share their interests with the class.

Listening and Talking: All the learning activities have all been designed to develop the children's social skills and academic skills.

Writing: Block 4 will focus on developing the children's explanation, persuasive and setting writing skills.

Spelling: The children will develop their spelling skills every day through active and written activities.

The children will all have a different classroom role each week (e.g. tidying the toys, hoovering) they will be encouraged to do that same task at home each day to help their family.



Forest School Crafts: The children will create products made from elder wood they have sustainably foraged.

They will be making

- Elder duck callers (for attracting ducks to feed)
- Elder whistles
- Elder jewellery beads and pendants
- Elder spud/pee shooters
