WINTER WEATHER

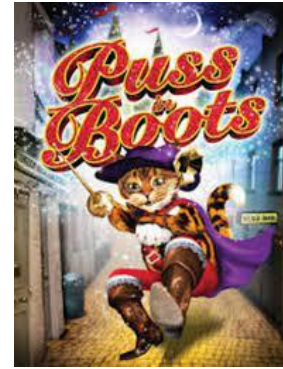

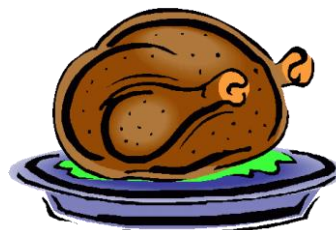
