#### P1 REGISTRATION 2024-2025

Parent/Carers of children due to start school in August 2024 will be invited to register their child online for the catchment school for their home address.

You can enrol your child from 6<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> November 2023.

Applications should be made via the online application form on Glasgow City Council's website. (While online applications are quick and easy, families can also request a paper copy by contacting the council on 0141 287 8000)

Any parents considering deferring their child must still register at the local catchment school.

If your child is 5 between 1st March 2024 and 28th February 2025, then he/she is eligible to start school.
