LITERACY

Reading – Children will be continuing to develop their reading skills through daily reading of our reading scheme Big Cat. This will include phonic decodable readers. They will complete comprehension activities to assess their understanding of what they have read.

Listening and Talking – As part of our learning in our Scotland topic children will learn the words to the poem 'Wee Willie Winkie' by William Miller. They will have the opportunity to perform this to the class and 2 finalists will be chosen for the school finals.

Writing – Primary 1 will continue to make use of their knowledge of phonics to complete 'have a go' writing activities.

Spelling – Children will be using their knowledge of sounds taught so far to spell simple words.

French – Children will explore conversational

NUMERACY



In numeracy children will continue to practise number formation and will begin to work on number bonds to ten. We will also be introducing time and will be learning to read o'clock times on analogue and digital clocks. Primary 1 will also be introduced to money and will be learning to identify coins up to £2 and select the correct coins to pay for an item.

We will also be looking at solving division problems by sharing and grouping objects equally.



HWB: Our focus for this term is dealing with conflict and change; resilience and rights and responsibilities.

PE: Children can come dressed in comfortable/sports clothes and trainers on gym day. P.E will take place on a Thursday afternoon. This term we will be focussing on football and basketball.

Homework

Home learning will no longer be issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities are available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab. Each term, I will issue a set of common words and sound cards to help support your child at home with these.



Outdoor Learning: We will be learning to explore our outdoor environment and what happens to our surroundings/how things change in this cold winter weather.

Scotland Topic – We will be learning about Scotland and our local environment. Children will have the opportunity to learn about some famous Scots and explore the Scots language through Scottish songs and poems. We will also explore Knights and Castles and the role they played in history.
