For the past few weeks we have been learning our number bond facts. Today we will be doing the story of IO and looking at all the ways you can make IO. For this activity you will need two plates and 10 objects which you can use to help you count, such as toy cars, pasta, small toys etc. Share your 10 objects between the two plates to make different number sentences for 10 . For example, 5 cars on one plate and 5
on the other would mean $5+5=10$. Use the template below to show all the ways you can make 10 .
