


# Literacy: Phonics

Over the past few weeks, we have been focusing on learning how to spell cvc words. (cvc words are short words made of consonant, vowel, consonant) and we have spent time identifying initial sounds, ends sounds and middle sounds in cvc words. Today we would like to 'have a go' at putting all this learning together and try spelling whole cvc words, as independently as possible.

#### Common words




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# Numeracy: Measure - Weight
