Some kind of fool?

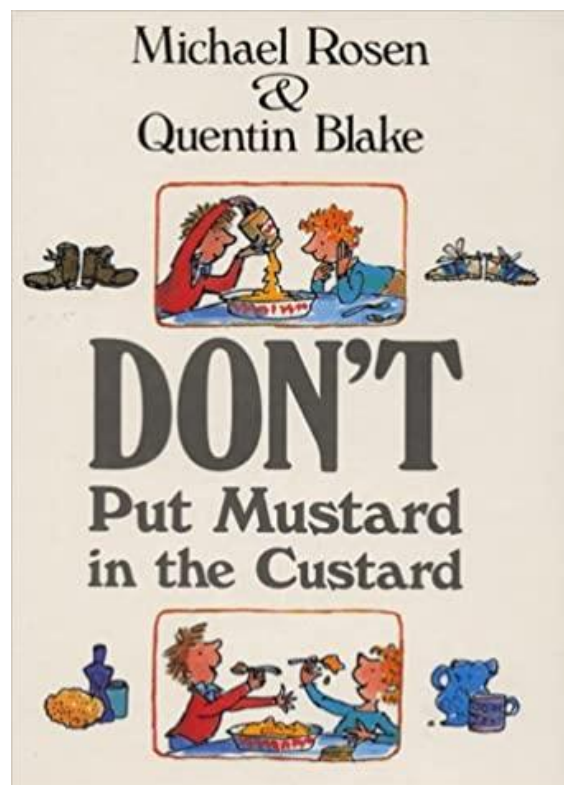
One day

and don't throw fruit at a computer.

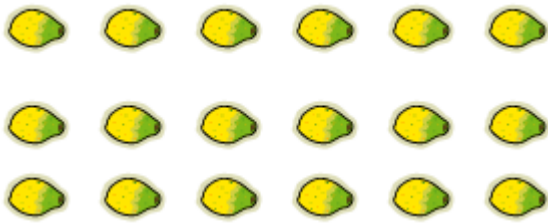

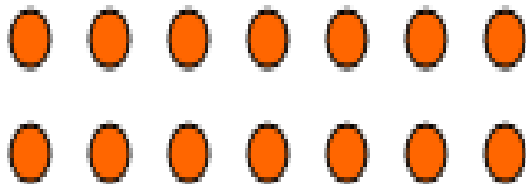
Estimation is when we try to find a value to the right answer. After you have watched the lesson complete the activities below.

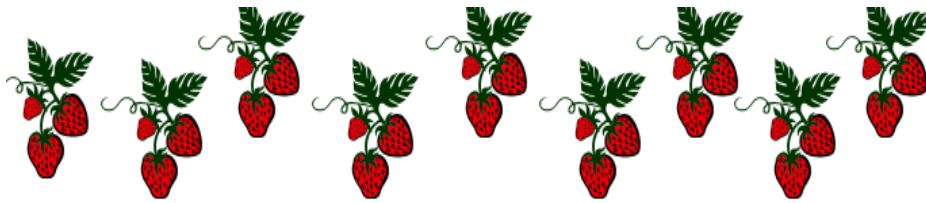

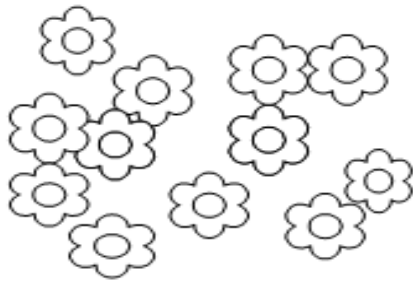

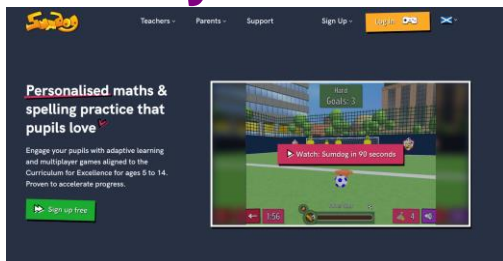
