Literacy



Reading - In reading Primary 2 will be developing their ability to read aloud with increasing fluency and expression. To support their reading skills, we will be focussing on common words and developing their knowledge of phonics.

Talking and Listening - Children will listen to stories and give feedback on what they have heard. They will develop skills in turn-taking during talking and listening.

Spelling - Primary 2 will take part in daily active spelling activities. They will be encouraged to apply their phonics skills when spelling words independently.

Writing - In writing, Primary 2 will be exploring recount and procedural writing in a range of contexts. They will recount their weekend through 'Have a Go' news writing, alongside other writing activities. This will provide pupils with an opportunity to develop their core writing skills, such as using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

French - We will begin to embed French into our daily routines such as greetings, days of the week and the weather. We will also explore fruits.

NUMERACY



Numeracy: In numeracy, children will explore whole number up to 100 and develop their understanding of place value.

They will practise rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and develop their addition skills using one- and two-digit numbers, with totals up to 20. Children will also explore time by sequencing days, months and seasons, and will develop their understanding of money using coins up to £1.

Maths: In maths, children will explore 2D and 3D shapes and learn about their properties.

H&WB: Our focus for this block is Values and Emotions. Children will be exploring the School Values, RESPECT and the Sandwood Voyagers. We will explore different emotions and learn how to express our feelings.



PE: This will take place on Tuesday (indoor) and Wednesday (outdoor). Please ensure children wear suitable footwear and clothing for all weather conditions when outside. As per GCC Health & Safety Physical Education guidelines, pupils **cannot** have jewellery or earrings in.

Homework

Home learning is no longer issued by class teachers. Social Studies/Science/Technology: Our topic this block is Dinosaurs.

Expressive Arts Children will develop a range of expressive arts skills through our class topic of Dinosaurs.

RME We will be exploring the story of Ruth and learning about beliefs and traditions within Judaism. We will also explore Christian practices and traditions, considering how Christians demonstrate and celebrate their beliefs.

Outdoor Learning: We will carry out a variety of outdoor learning experiences across the curriculum.

STEM: Children will take part in a variety of STEM challenges linked to our class topic of Dinosaurs.
