Reading - Children will continue to develop their expression, fluency and independence with their own text. As a class we will also be looking at various stories to identify characters, setting and story structure.

Talking and Listening- This term we will continue to develop our talking and listening skills through class discussion on a range of topics.

Phonics - Primary 2 will continue to learn new digraphs (2letters making one sound) and will use their knowledge of read and to spell a wide variety of words.

Writing - Primary 2 will be continuing to recount their weekend through 'news' writing. We will also be focussing on setting this term, using description bubbles and adjectives to enhance our writing. We will continue to consolidate our learning through various writing activities during topic time and RME.

French - Primary 2 will continue to embed French into their daily classroom routines.

In numeracy, Primary 2 will continue to apply their learning on numeracy strategies through addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Pupils will further their learning on area, time, measure, and grid referencing.

Within mental maths, we will be reinforcing multiplication facts for 2, 4, 5 and 10 times tables. Strengthening number bonds, reordering and estimating.



H&WB - Primary 2 will exploring relationships and health this term.

P.E. - We have P.E. on Monday and Thursday afternoons. Thursday afternoons will be our outdoor Muga slot. Our focus this term will be sports from the Commonwealth Games. This will help develop our teamwork skills and link with our topic. Please ensure all jewellery is removed on these days
