## Bossy Verbs!

Today we are going to look at Bossy Verbs.

Verbs are doing words. They help the reader understand what the person, animal or thing is doing. For example, The young boy is **running**. The verb 'running' tells us what the young boy is doing.

A bossy verb is a type of verb that tells us to do something. Bossy verbs are usually used when giving someone instructions. For example: **Stop** running around. The bossy verb 'stop' is telling us what to do.

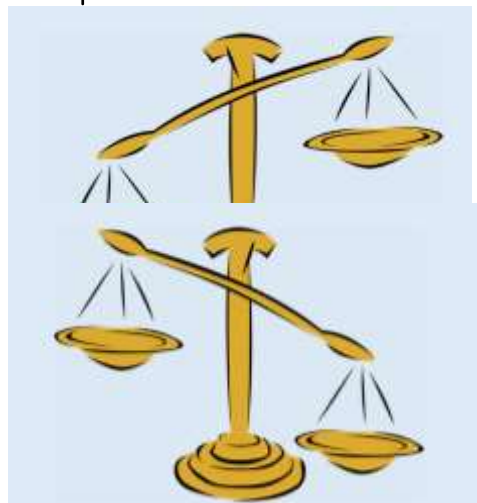
