### Shape Poetry

Today we are going to have a go at making some shape poems. Shape poems are exactly what they sound like. It is a poem that is shaped like the thing it describes. The shape adds to the meaning of the poem. For example, a poem about the stars would take the shape of a star (or stars).

Here is an example below.

This is a shape poem about a star.

As you can see, it is written in the shape of a star.



### Spelling Selection

#### Air Writing

Write your words in the air with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write. Or, ask someone to air write the letters you tell them to spell your word.

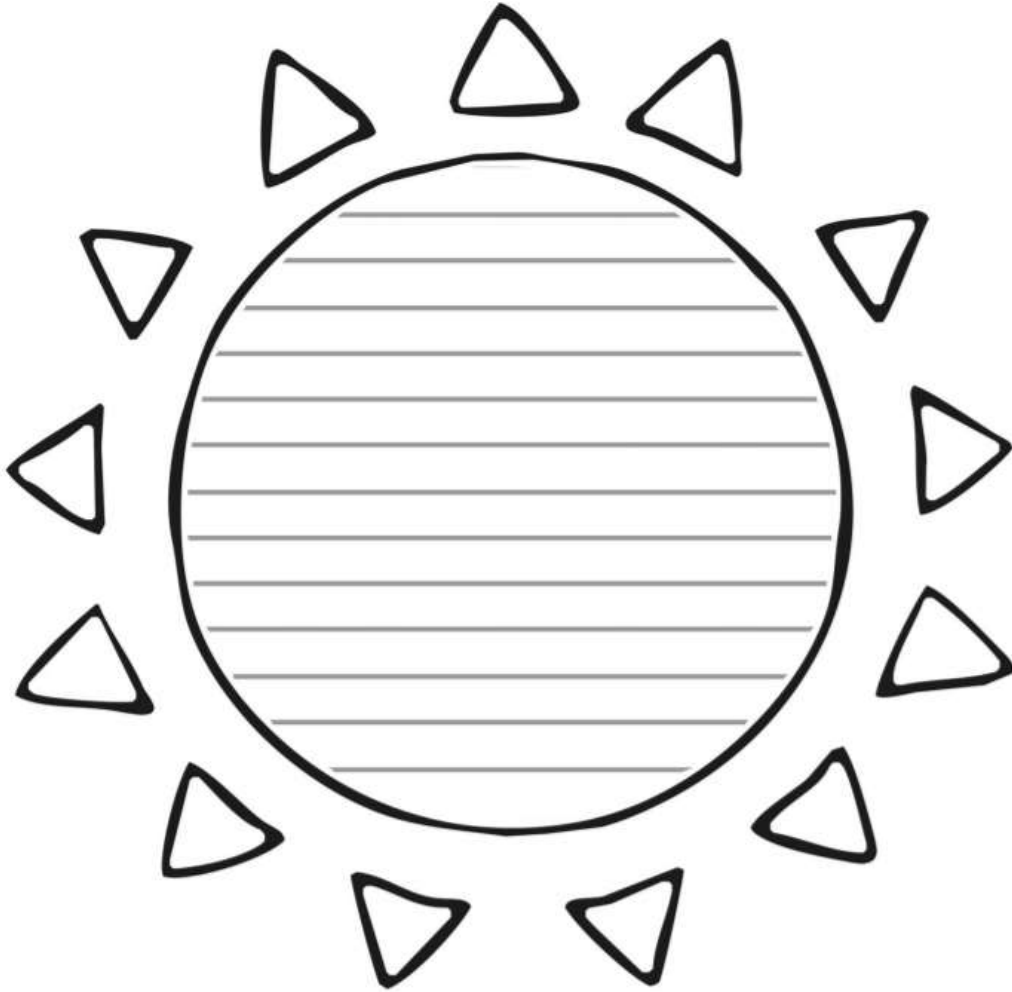


You can also write the words of the poem inside the shape rather than around the outside. Look at the next example.

Measure how tall you are and mark your height with masking tape on the floor. Place objects side by side next to your height. Can you find a combination of objects that measures the same length as your height?



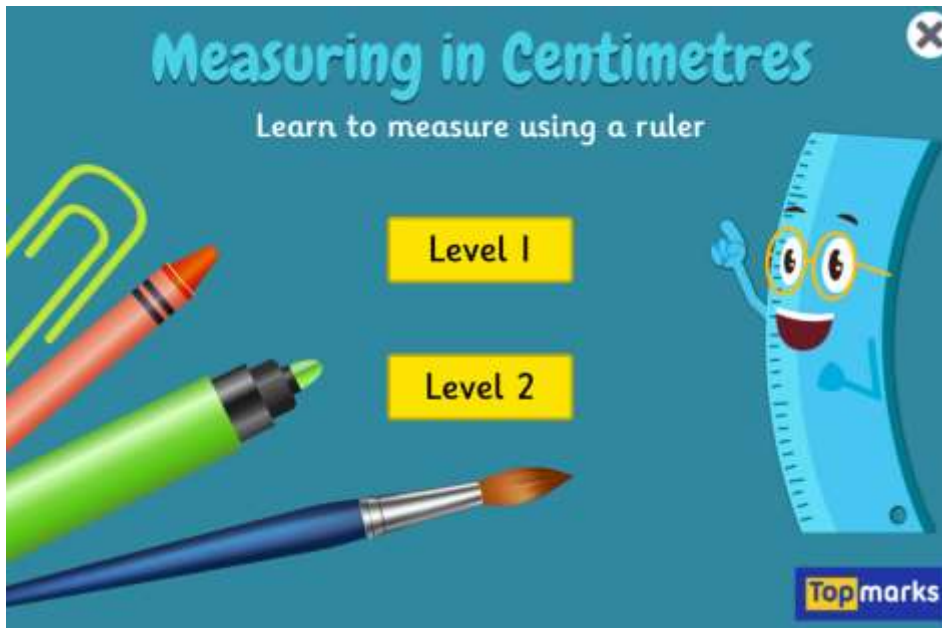
Measuring Length

E.g. the door is 16 pencils wide.

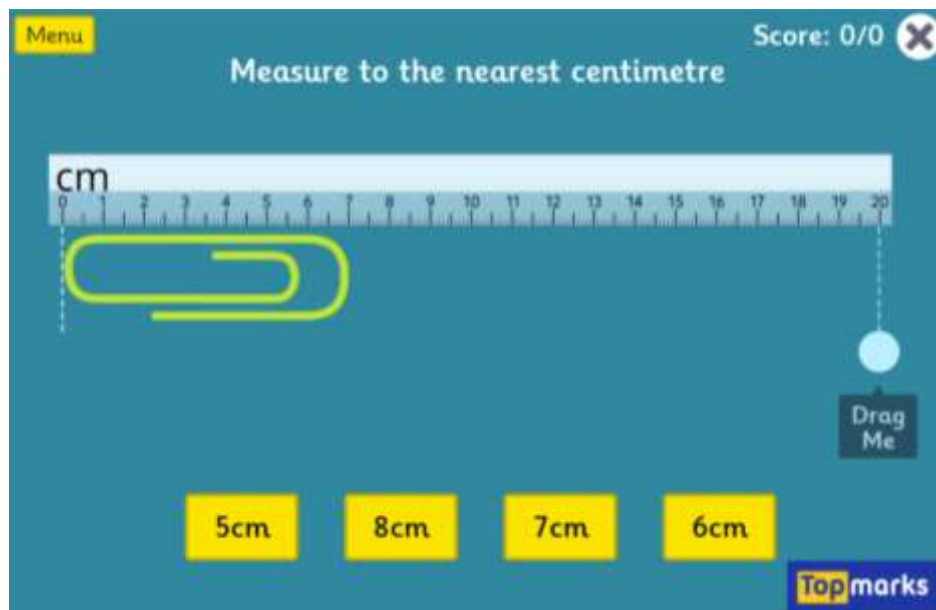


## Interactive Measuring Game
