



P2/3 Class Information

Reading - Children will continue to develop their expression, fluency and independence with their own text. As a class we will also be looking at "The Jolley-Rogers and the Monster's Gold" by Jonny Duddle as part of a book study relating to topic.

Talking and Listening- This term we will continue to develop our talking and listening skills through class discussion on a range of topics.

Spelling - Primary 2/3 will continue to spell common words and will use their knowledge of phonics to spell independently.

Writing - Primary 2/3 will be continuing to recount their weekend through 'news' writing. We will also be focussing on setting this term, using adjectives to enhance our writing. We will continue to consolidate our learning on question marks, exclamation marks and conjunctions.

French - Primary 2/3 will continue to embed French into their daily classroom routines.



In numeracy, Primary 2/3 will continue to apply their learning on numeracy strategies through addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Pupils will further their learning on measure, this term's focus being area and length.

In mathematics we will learn about grid referencing, children will have the opportunity to apply their learning when looking at maps in our topic lessons. Within mental maths, we will be reinforcing multiplication facts for 2, 4, 5 and 10 times tables. We will also continue to work on time and missing numbers.



H&WB - Primary 2/3 will be exploring relationships and health this term.

P.E. - We have P.E. on a Tuesday and Friday. Our focus this term is Potted Sports, Racquet skills and Relay races. Please ensure all jewellery is removed on these days as I am not permitted to remove earrings in class.



Homework will be issued on a **Tuesday** to be completed by the following **Monday**. This will allow families time to work on homework activities over the weekend. We suggest that no more than 10 - 15 minutes is spent on homework each night. Children will be given a reading book on **Tuesday**, this should also be returned the following **Monday** in order to receive the next reading book. I will continue to send home common words as pupils move through the set, to allow them to be reinforced at home.



Social Studies/Science/Technology - Our focus this term will be Pirates.

Expressive Arts - Children will learn different skills through our class topic.

RME - This term we will be learning about Muhammad's Life.

Outdoor Learning - We will carry out a range of outdoor learning experiences across the curriculum.

Digital Literacy - We will continue to use the iPads to enhance our digital technology skills.
