



P3 Class Information

Reading- In reading, Primary 3, will be developing their ability to read aloud with increasing fluency and expression. To support their reading skills, we will continue to focus on common words and further developing their knowledge of phonics.

Talking and Listening- We will be preparing a presentation of the poem 'Scottish Rain' by Tom Bryan, focussing on presentation skills volume, pace and expression. Daily, pupils are encouraged to share their opinions and offer feedback during class discussions linked with Newsround and our class story.

Spelling- Primary 3 will take part in daily active spelling activities. They will be encouraged to spell words independently using their knowledge of phonics.

Writing- In writing, Primary 3 will be exploring poetry, persuasive and explanation writing. The children will be focussing on writing texts linked with our topic and use subject specific vocabulary as well as extending their range of vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation.

French - We will embed French into our daily routines such as greetings, days of the week and counting.



Numeracy - In numeracy, children will be exploring fractions, directional language, measure and data handling. We will continue learning our 2, 3, 4, 5, 10 times table. We will also be learning to make totals and give change to £5-£10. For measure, primary 3 will be focusing on weight (kg and g) and volume (l and ml).



H&WB: Our focus for this block is dealing with conflict, resilience and rights and responsibilities.

PE: P3 have PE on a **Tuesday**, indoor, and **Thursday**, outdoor. In January we will be learning Scottish Country Dancing along with developing skills in basketball and football. Please ensure all jewellery is removed before coming to school on these days and please remember to bring appropriate footwear.



Home learning will no longer be issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities are available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab. Termly spelling words and common words can be requested to be sent home.



Social Studies/Science/Technology: We are learning about Scotland and our local area and the rainforest this term.

Expressive Arts: Children will learn different skills in art, drama and music linked throughout learning. We will be looking at Charles Rennie Mackintosh as a link to our Scotland topic.

RME: We will be learning about Eid-ul-Fitr and Easter symbols.

Digital Literacy: P3 will develop their digital skills by using the school iPad's. We will use Book Creator to create a non-fiction book about our topic using text and images. We will continue with our coding programme and use different apps to practise our maths skills.

Uniform - make sure all items of uniform are labelled.
