Writing: Poetry

(Watch/listen to my direct teaching point on SeeSaw and then complete this follow up work or join MS Teams for this lesson)

We are moving on to the new genre of writing, poetry. Poetry is a piece of writing that uses imaginative words to share ideas, emotions or a story to the reader. Many poems have words or phrases that sound good together when they are read aloud. Most poems for children rhyme e.g

Jack and Jill
Went up the hill
To fetch a pail of water
Jack fell down
And broke his crown
And Jill came tumbling after



However, not all poems have to rhyme.

Today, we are going to be using our similes that we learned about last week and write a Simile poem all about ourselves. Remember that a simile is when you compare two things using the words 'like' or 'as' e.g

- She was as busy as a bee.
- He was as strong like an ox.
- They were as quiet as mice.

Look at the following About Me example.

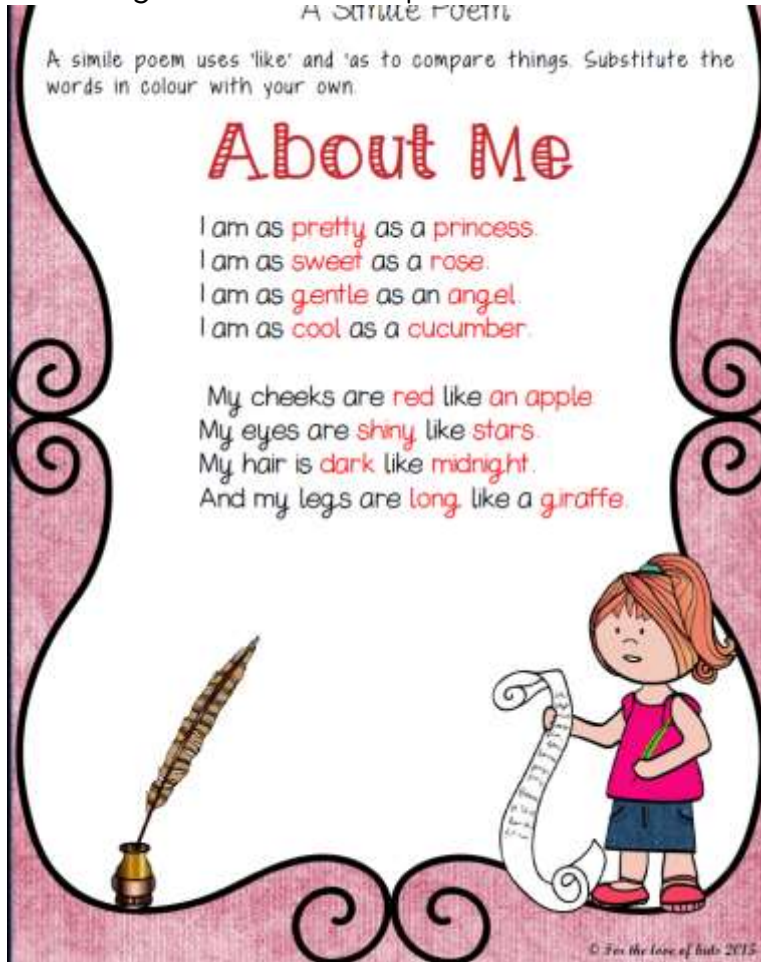
A SIMILE POEM

A simile poem uses 'like' and 'as' to compare things. Substitute the words in colour with your own.

About Me

I am as **pretty** as a princess.
I am as **sweet** as a rose.
I am as **gentle** as an angel.
I am as **cool** as a cucumber.

My cheeks are **red** like an apple.
My eyes are **shiny** like stars.
My hair is **dark** like midnight.
And my legs are **long** like a giraffe.



For the first verse select some adjectives to describe yourself e.g.

clever	kind	beautiful
strong	loving	stylish

and compare using 'as' to something that best describes this e.g. I am as clever as a wise owl.

For the second verse, compare your physical features (what you look like) e.g.

hair	eyes	nose
feet	legs	face

And compare using 'like' e.g.

My eyes are crystal blue like the ocean.

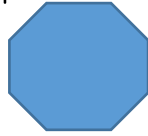
