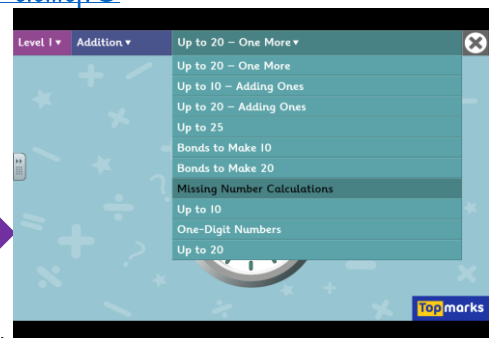

10 pairs of socks

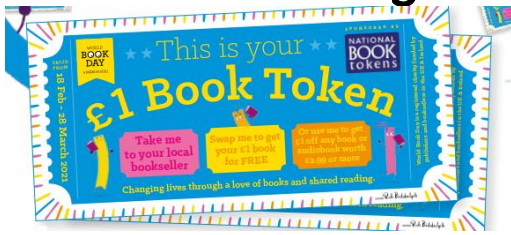

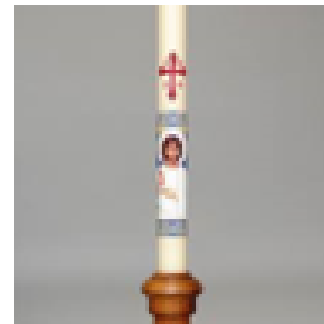
We are continuing to follow our planned Religious and Moral Education Programme. We are now learning about the Christian Festival of Easter.

Candles are burned during many Easter celebrations. Many churches blow out candles on Good Friday to show that Jesus' light has gone out.



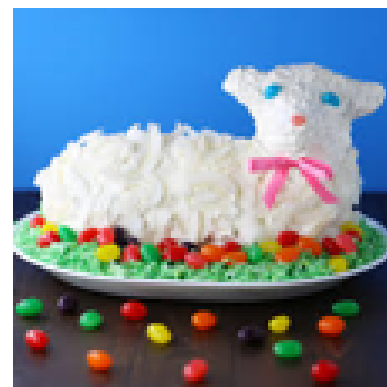
In Roman Catholic churches, the special paschal candle is lit on Easter Sunday, representing Jesus' return to life.
