



P3/4 Class Information

Reading - Children will continue to develop their expression, fluency and independence with their own text. As a class we will also be looking at "This Morning I Met a Whale" by Michael Morpurgo.

Talking and Listening- This term we will continue to develop our talking and listening skills through class discussion on a range of topics.

Spelling - Primary 3/4 will continue to spell common words and will use their knowledge of phonics to spell independently.

Writing - Primary 3/4 will be continuing to transfer their writing skills across the curriculum. We will also be focussing on setting this term, using adjectives and onomatopoeia to enhance our writing. We will continue to consolidate our learning on question marks, exclamation marks and conjunctions.

French - Primary 3/4 will continue to embed French into their daily classroom routines.



In numeracy, Primary 3/4 will continue to apply their learning on numeracy strategies through addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Pupils will further their learning on measure, this term's focus being area and length.

In mathematics we will learn about grid referencing and being able to read and times with quarter past/to and 5 minute intervals.

Within mental maths, we will be reinforcing multiplication facts for 2 to 10 times tables and using the 4 operations to calculate answers mentally.



H&WB - Primary 3/4 will be exploring relationships and health this term.

P.E. - We have P.E. on a **Tuesday (outdoor)** and **Wednesday (indoor)**. Our focus this term is athletics and racquet skills. Please ensure all jewellery is removed on these days as I am not permitted to remove earrings in class.



We are working on providing paper copies of homework this session. I will also provide a homework jotter this term for literacy. Homework will be issued on a **Tuesday** to be completed by the following **Monday**. This will allow families time to work on homework activities over the weekend. We suggest that no more than 10 - 15 minutes is spent on homework each night. Children's will be given a reading book on **Tuesday**, this should also be returned the following **Monday** in order to receive the next reading book.



Social Studies/Science/Technology - children will be working collaboratively in STEM challenges linked to our novel study with a focus on prediction, problem solving, resilience and reasoning.

Expressive Arts - Children will learn different skills through our class topic.

RME - This term we will be learning about Festivals.

Digital Literacy - We will continue to use the iPads to develop our coding skills by creating and de-bugging algorithms and showing our creativity through use of Book Creator and iMovie.

Uniform - make sure all items of uniform are labelled.
