LITERACY

Reading

Children will continue to develop their expression, fluency and independence using their reading books. As a class, we will also read *Flat Stanley: The Great Egyptian Grave Robbery* as part of a book study linked to our Ancient Egypt topic.

Talking and Listening

This term, we will continue to develop talking and listening skill through class discussions across a range of topics, encouraging children to share ideas, ask questions and listen respectfully to others.

Spelling

Primary 3/2 will continue to learn and spell common words and use their knowledge of phonics to support independent spelling in their writing.

Writing

Children will continue to recount their weekend experiences through 'news' writing. This term, there will be a focus on describing setting, using adjectives to enhance writing. We will also continue to consolidate the use of question marks, exclamation marks and conjunctions.

French

Primary 3/2 will continue to embed French into daily classroom routines, building confidence in listening and speaking.

NUMERACY

In numeracy, Primary 3/2 will continue to apply their learning of numeracy strategies through addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Pupils will further their learning in measure, with this term's focus on area and length.

In mathematics, we will learn about grid referencing and time, including reading analogue and digital clocks to tell the time to half past and quarter past/to.

Within mental maths, we will reinforce multiplication facts for the 2 to 10 times tables and use the four operations to calculate answers mentally.



H&WB - Primary 3/2 will be exploring relationships and health this term.

P.E. – We have P.E. on a Tuesday, indoor, and Wednesday, outdoor. Our focus this term is potted sports, racquet skills and relay races. Please ensure all jewellery is removed on these days as I am not permitted to remove earrings in class.

Homework

Home learning is no longer issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities is available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab. Each term, I will send home the sounds the children are learning each week, along with some spelling words linked to these sounds. This will allow you to see what we are focusing on in class. If you require jotters for home learning, please do not hesitate to ask.



Social Studies/Science/Technology - Our focus this term will be Ancient Egypt.

Expressive Arts - Children will learn different skills through our class topic.

RME – This term we will be learning about Muhammad's Life.
