## LITERACY



**Reading** - In reading, the children will be looking at non-fiction books to develop their understanding of the difference between fiction and non-fiction texts. Daily group reading will support the children to read with increasing fluency and expression.

**Listening and Talking** - During weekly news, pupils will be practising their listening skills and showing respect to peers. They will also be encouraged to share their opinions and offer feedback during class discussions.

**Writing** - This term's focuses are poetry, explanation, and persuasive writing. The children will continue to write their News on a weekly basis.

**Spelling** - P3/2 will continue to make progress through their common words and through their weekly phonics input.

**French** - We will be looking at days of the week, weather, and classroom instructions.

## NUMERACY



### Numeracy and Maths

Primary 3/2 will be exploring measure, with a focus on weight and volume, directional language and data handling. The children will progress with their learning of money from term 1, by learning how to make totals and give change.

In addition to this, we will also be looking at fractions to recognise halves, thirds, quarters, fifths, sixths and tenths.

We will continue to develop mental agility through a range of teaching approaches and daily mental maths.



**H&WB:** Our focuses this term are: Dealing with Conflict and Change, Resilience, and Rights and Responsibilities.

**PE:** P3/2 will have P.E. on Tuesdays in the MUGA and on Thursdays with the Determined2Dance coaches.

Please ensure that all jewellery is removed before coming to school on these days. Children should also remember to bring appropriate footwear for P.E.

## Homework

Home learning is no longer issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities is available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab. Each term, I will send home the sounds the children are learning each week, along with some spelling words linked to these sounds. This will allow you to see what we are focusing on in class. If you require jotters for home learning, please do not hesitate to ask.



**Social Studies/Science/Technology:** Our topics this block are 'Scotland' and 'The Rainforest.'

**Expressive Arts:** Children will learn about different skills through our topic such as colour mixing, texture and tone.

**RME:** We will be learning about Eid-ul-Fitr and Easter symbols.

**Outdoor Learning:** We will carry out a variety of outdoor learning experiences across the curriculum. We will visit the school garden once a week, weather permitting.
