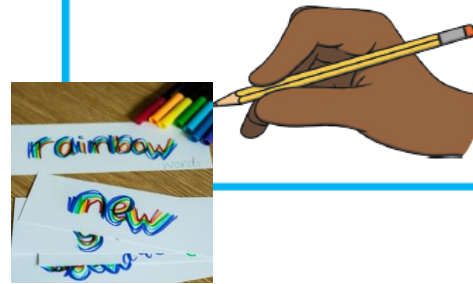
Write each of your spelling words 5 times using Rainbow writing. For example

Before Reading



- Read the title together. Make pictures in your head.
- What do you already know about the word "wee"?
- Have you heard this Scots word before?
- Look at the front cover. What do you notice?
- What do you think the story may be about?
- Where do you think the story may take place?
- Look at the illustrations on the front cover. What do you notice about the character on the front cover? How is she feeling?
- Do you have any questions about the story?





During Reading



- Describe Wee Granny's magic bag.
- What did Wee Granny and the children do last Christmas?
- If you were at the seaside, what would you like to be pulled out of Wee Granny's magic bag?
- Wee Granny brought sandwiches and orange juice for the picnic. If you were having a picnic with Wee Granny, what would you bring?
- What did Wee Granny and the children need to bake cakes for the school fair?
- A warm smell of baking filled the park. Describe what Wee Granny might see and hear in the park.
- Do you think that Wee Granny's magic bag is magic? Why? Use the text to support your answer.

- Did it remind you of any other stories?
- Who was your favourite character? Why?
- If you had a magic bag, what would you have inside it?
- How would you describe Wee Granny? Try to use some Scots language.

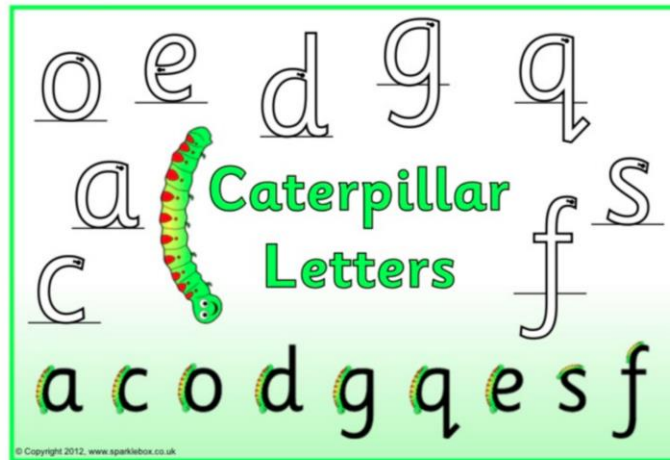
Video explaining Curly Caterpillars on Seesaw.

The pictures below outline the correct formation and where to start each letter.



Letter formation

Start on the dot, follow letter through in the direction of arrow.

SET 1: Caterpillar letters

 Start at the top, halfway round	 all the way round, up and down	 Start at the top, all the way round
 all the way round, up, up and down	 all the way round, up, down with a curly tail	 all the way round, up, down and kick
 across the middle, up and around	 over the top, across the middle and back	 over and down, then cross it

Remember to try and join all letters that join in your word.

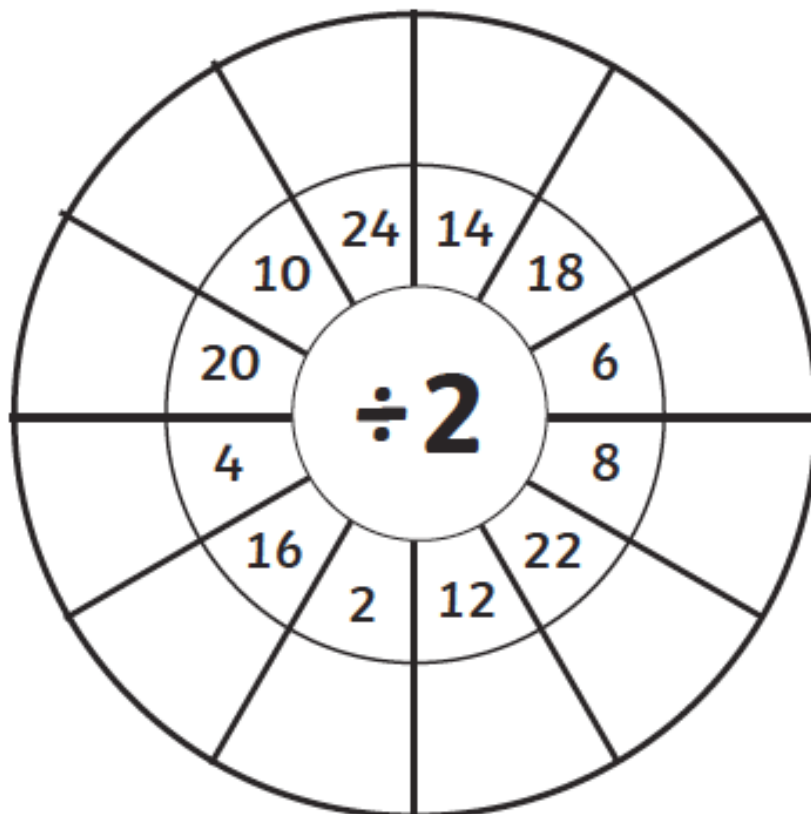

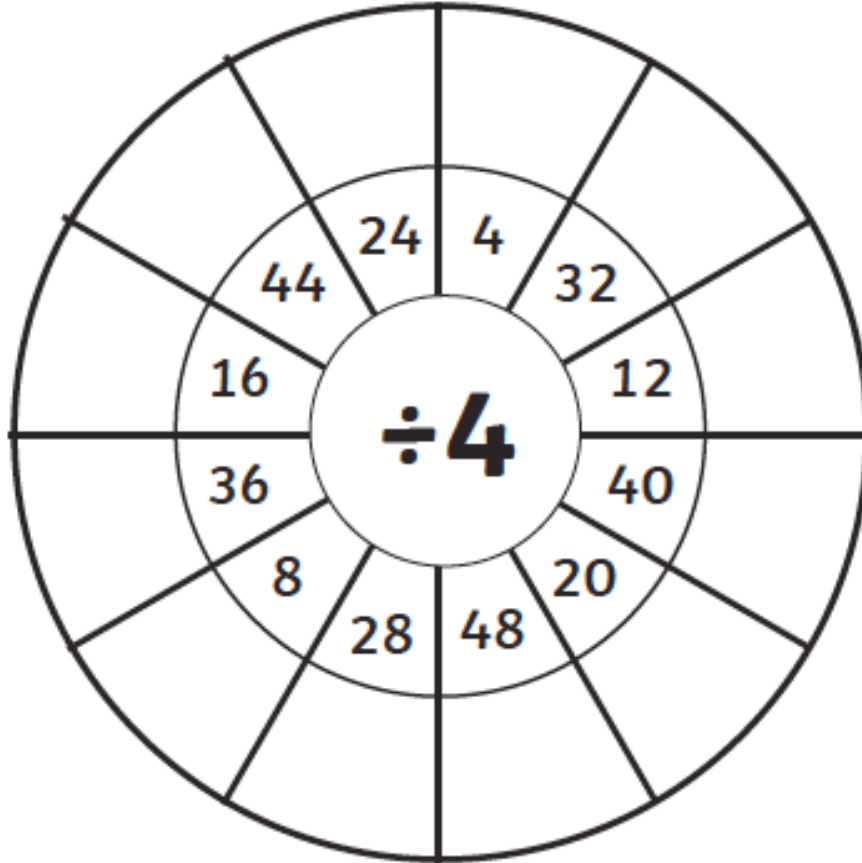
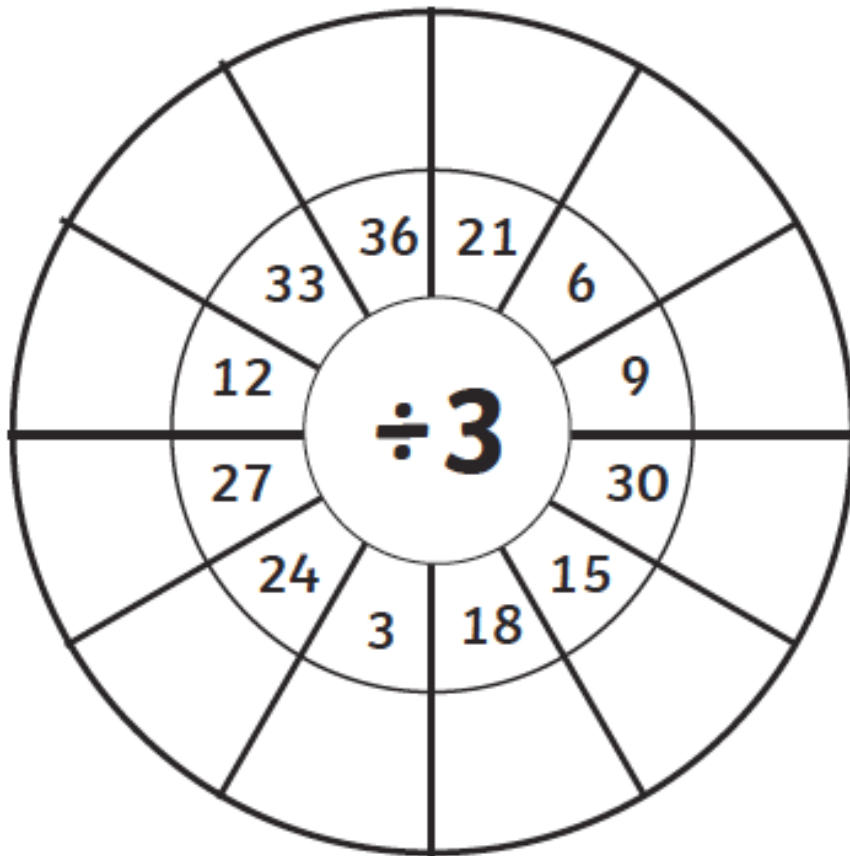
