



# P4 Class Information

**BLOCK 4**  
**2025-26**



**Reading** - This term we will be doing a novel study on 'The Witches' by Roald Dahl. We will be using this book to develop our reading skills in answering questions, looking at the author's writing techniques and studying character and setting as inspiration for our writing pieces. We will also be continuing with our reading scheme books.

**Listening and Talking** - We will be reading our class novel aloud and discussing elements such as using punctuation cues and reading with expression.

**Writing** - This term's focus is setting. Children will develop their skills in writing using adjectives, adverbs, similes, metaphors, personification, connectives, openers and different types of punctuation.

**Spelling** - Children will work through the individualised spelling programmes. There will be an emphasis on correct pronunciation of words to support children with this. Children should also learn weekly common words.

**French** - In French, we will be learning how to talk about the weather.



This term we will be telling the time for 5-minute intervals on a digital and analogue clock. We will also be solving expressions and equations, finding area and measuring length. We will be converting between cm m and mm/cm. In shape, we will be identifying and creating tiling patterns. We will be using 2 figure references for plotting and reading co-ordinates. We will continue to reinforce our skills in addition, subtraction, fractions, multiplication and division by answering word problems and mental maths.



**Health & Wellbeing:** This block our focus is on the RSHP (relationships, sexual health and parenthood) programme

**PE:** We have PE on **Tuesday and Thursday**. Our focus this term will be hockey and athletics.



Home learning will no longer be issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities are available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab. Pupils are still welcome to borrow a book from the class library to read at home for pleasure and they also have their Sumdog login details, which can be used at home to help develop their mental maths skills.

**Expressive Arts:** Children will learn about different skills through our class novel 'The Witches'.

**RME:** Our learning context will be 'David'.

**Outdoor Learning:** We will carry out a variety of outdoor learning experiences across the curriculum.

**Digital Literacy:** We will continue to develop our digital skills using our iPads.

**STEM:** We will be working on the Maths BURST programme developing our spatial reasoning skills.
