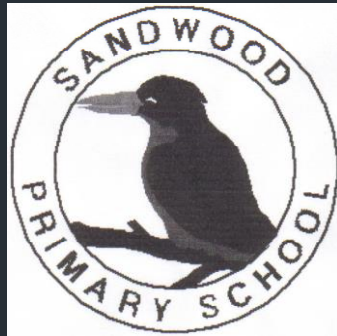
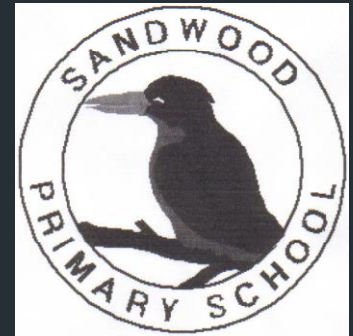

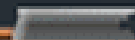

Yearly Overview

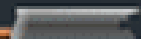
- Flexible approach to timetable.
- Literacy, handwriting, numeracy and mental maths daily.
- PE twice weekly - Tuesday and Wednesday (changes termly).
- Assembly once a fortnight.
- Committee meetings termly.

Literacy

- Reading: non-fiction.
- Writing: recount, procedural and report.
- Grammar and Punctuation: VCOP.
- Talking and Listening: strategies, creating views and opinions and express these.
- Spelling: Nelson - each group on individualised plan.
- Common Words: Fry's - homework.
- Handwriting: Nelson Script - break letters, formation of basic joins, introduce the use of pens.

Maths and Numeracy

- Numeracy: place value, addition, rounding, money and multiplication.
- Maths: shape and time.
- Mental maths: times table, problem solving and applying different strategies.
- Active maths: games, whiteboards, silent teaching and technology.
- Outdoor learning: context and enterprise opportunities.

 - October: personal safety

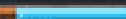
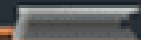
