

## P4/5 Class Information

**BLOCK 4** 2023-24



Reading - This term we will be doing a novel study on James and the Giant Peach' by Roald Dahl. We will be using this book to develop our reading skills in answering questions, looking at the author's writing techniques and studying character and setting as inspiration for our writing pieces. We will also be continuing with our reading scheme books and taking books home weekly.

Listening and Talking - We will be reading our class novel aloud and discussing elements such as using punctuation cues and reading with expression.

Writing - This term's focus is setting and short story. Children will develop their skills in writing using adjectives, adverbs, similes, metaphors, personification, connectives, openers and different types of punctuation.

Spelling - Children will work through the individualised spelling programmes. There will be an emphasis on correct pronunciation of words to support children with this. Children should also learn weekly common words.

French - P4/5 will develop conversational French skills.





This term we will be solving equations with algebra and using a 4-quadrant grid for plotting and reading coordinates. We will be learning to convert between mm, cm and m and measure perimeter and area. We will also be looking at problems relating to time.

We will continue to reinforce our skills in addition, subtraction, fractions, multiplication and division by answering word problems and mental maths calculations.

Health & Wellbeing: This block our focus is on the RSHP (relationships, sexual health and parenthood) programme



PE: We have PE on Monday and Thursday. Our focus will be athletics and hockey. We complete the daily mile in school also
