Reading

Children will continue to develop their expression, fluency and independence with their own text. We will be focusing on higher order thinking skills and the ability to infer and evaluate information from a text to promote a deeper understanding.

Listening and Talking

We will continue to watch our daily Newsround bulletin and use this as a context to create, ask and respond to a range of different question types. Children will have the opportunity to share and present their learning on our Viking topic.

Writing

This term our focus will be Fiction writing and we will be exploring settings and short stories. We will identify the key components of a good story and will create our own short stories with interesting characters, detailed plots and exciting endings! We will be challenging everyone to use a range of VCOP skills to up-level their writing and consistently use the joined script.

French

Children will continue to develop their conversational French.



This term we will be solving equations with algebra. Learning to read, write and plot co-ordinates in 4 quadrants. We will also be learning to convert between mm, cm and m and calculate perimeter and area.

We will continue to reinforce our number skills in addition, subtraction, fractions, multiplication and division by answering word problems along with written and mental calculations.



This term we will have a focus on the RSHP (relationships, sexual health and parenthood) programme. We will also be looking at skills for work and discussing careers and pathways.

This term our P.E. days will be Tuesday (outdoor) and Wednesday (indoor).



Home learning will no longer be issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities are available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab. Pupils are still welcome to borrow a book from the class library to read at home for pleasure and they also have their Sumdog login details, which can be used at home to help develop their mental maths skills.



This term we will be looking at 'The Vikings' as our context for learning. Pupils will be learning about the history of the Vikings and the areas they lived and travelled too. We will also be looking at the Vikings through a S.T.E.M. lens, investigating design features of the longboats and their homes and having a go at designing and building our own ships.
