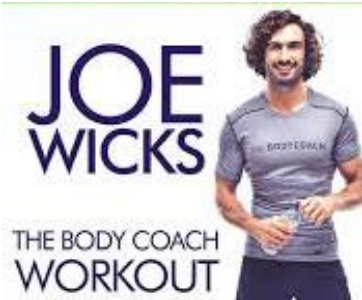

### Multiplying with Decimals



Move decimal to right

Number of zeros = Number of place you move

Examples:

$$* 87.6 \times 100 = 8,760.0$$

Answer: 8,760.0 or 8,760

$$* 0.005 \times 1,000 = 5.0$$

Answer: 5.0 or 5

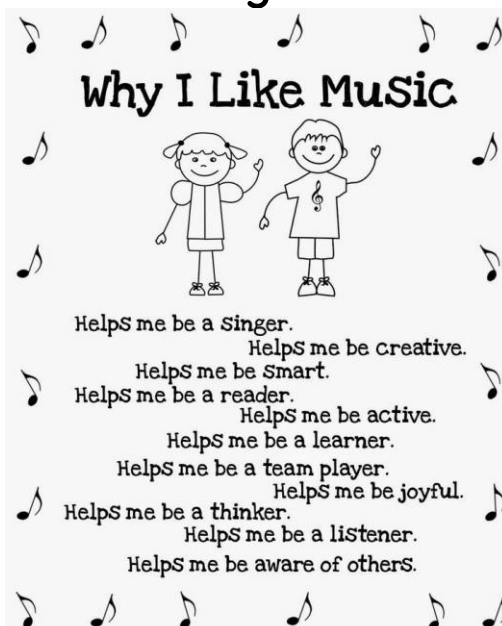
