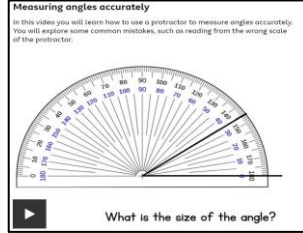
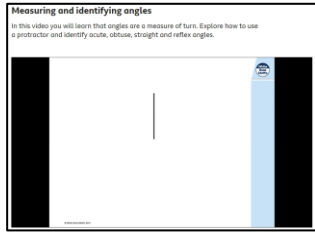

3. Can you find where the paragraphs should be in this passage?

## Mathematics: Angles and Symmetry

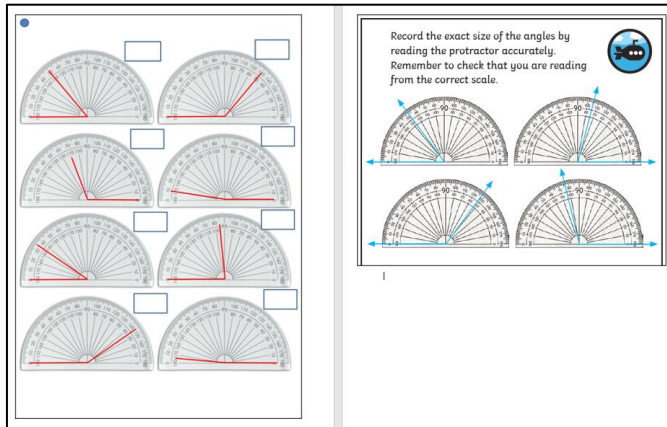
L.I: To use a protractor to measure an angle.
