

## P6 Class Information

BLOCK 1 2025-26



Reading - P6 will develop their reading skills by reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will focus on reading fluently and with expression during our guided reading sessions. We will also focus on answering literal, inferential and evaluative questions to show our understanding of what we have read. Furthermore, we will be identifying facts, opinions and will be evaluating the reliability of sources

Listening and Talking - This block we will have opportunities to work collaboratively and demonstrate effective communication skills. We will also be developing our ability to listen and interpret information by watching and reading non-fiction texts. Writing - This term we will focus on recount, report and procedural writing. We will be challenging everyone to use a range of VCOP in their writing. There will also be weekly spelling lists with activities and the use of the joined-up script is encouraged at all times.



In Numeracy we will be learning how to read, write, order and round up to 7-digit numbers with 2 decimal places. We will be focussing on addition strategies and answering word problems.

We will be continually revising our times tables and using these to multiple and divide.

We will be looking at measuring time using different units, solving problems with money using different operations and extending our knowledge of 3D shapes and identifying features of triangles and circles.

Health & Wellbeing: This month we will be learning about Emotions. As part of this topic we will be identifying different emotions, looking at triggers and discussing strategies for coping with our emotions. PE: Our P.E days are Thursdays and Fridays. Please ensure that pupils remove all jewellery and come to school with appropriate footwear. On Thursdays we will be developing our ball handling skills on the M.U.G.A and on Fridays we will be improving our stamina and fitness in the gym hall. We will also take part in the daily mile each day.

## Homework ()

This block homework will consist of reading, spelling and numeracy tasks as well as a Topic themed home learning grid to complete. Homework will be issued on a Tuesday to be completed by the following Monday. Pupils are also encouraged to use the Sumdog App or the Topmarks website to help develop their mental maths skills.

Social Studies - This block we will take part in the 'Glorious Glasgow' topic to celebrate the 850<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Glasgow. We will also be learning about the Victorian Era and will study aspects of Victorian times with an emphasis on Scotland. We will learn about what life was like during this time, make comparisons and the explore the inventions and people from this period.

Digital Literacy - we will be using the iPads to conduct research for our topic and to discuss the reliability of sources. We will also be developing our skills in using the mark up tools, Keynote and Book Creator to present our work digitally.
