Rat = 3, Seat = 4, etc.

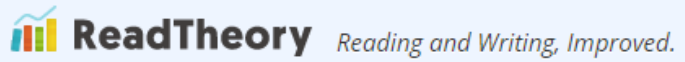
The bigger the word, the better your score. The letters do not need to be next to each other.
