What colour? You pronounce it "de kel coolur"

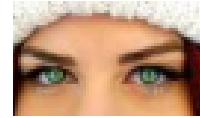
Last week we learned how to say "what colour is her hair?" This week we're learning how to say: "what colour are his/her eyes?"

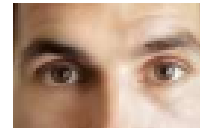
De quelle couleur sont ses yeux?
