



P7 Class Information

Reading - P7 will develop their reading skills, by reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will focus on reading fluently and with expression during our guided reading sessions. We will also focus on answering literal, inferential and evaluative questions to show our understanding of what we have read. Furthermore, we will be identifying facts, opinions and bias and will be evaluating the reliability of sources. We will be studying novels linking with our World War 1 topic.

Listening and Talking - This block we will have the opportunity to prepare and present a 'House Captain' speech. We will also be developing our ability to listen and interpret information by watching and reading non-fiction texts.

Writing - This term's focuses are recount, persuasive and procedural writing. We will be challenging everyone to use a range of VCOP skills and analyse features of these types of non-fiction texts. There will be weekly spelling words with activities, and the use of the joined-up script is always encouraged.

French - We will be developing our conversational French skills including numbers, greetings and birthdays.



In Numeracy we will be learning how to read, write, order and round up to 8-digit numbers with 3 decimal places. We will be focussing on addition strategies and answering multi-step problems. We will be looking at measuring time using different units, solving problems with money using different operations and creating nets of 3D and drawing triangles. We will be continually revising our times tables and using these to multiple and divide. We will be completely Numeracy Ninjas daily which focusses on mental strategies, times tables and key skills.

Health & Wellbeing: This month we will focus on the School Values and will also be looking at Emotions. As part of this topic, we will identify emotions, look at triggers and strategies for coping with our emotions.



PE: Our P.E days are **Tuesday (Handball)** and **Thursday (Badminton)**. Please ensure that pupils remove all jewellery and acrylic nails and come to school with appropriate footwear.



Home learning will no longer be issued by class teachers. However, if you would like to support your child's learning at home, a wide range of activities are available through the school app and the school website. On the app, this information can be found in the *Classes* section, and on the website, it is located under the *Home Learning* tab.



Social Studies: This block we will be learning about World War 1. As well as learning lots of facts about the War, we will have the opportunity to develop our research and presentation skills.

Digital Literacy: We will be using iPads to research our topic and discuss reliability of sources of information. We will also be using the iPad to consolidate our learning across the curriculum, through on-line games and presenting work digitally.
