Scottish Landmark Research some facts about a Scottish landmark. You could also draw and label your chosen landmark.	Scottish Food Create a menu using only Scottish ingredients and produce.	Famous Scots Choose a famous Scot to research and create a biography all about their life.	Scotland's Flags Draw and research facts about Scotland's 2 national flags. Why don't you use your knowledge of Scotland to create a new national flag? Think about the colours and images that you could include.
Scottish Artists Research a famous Scottish artist and have a go at re-creating their work.	Scottish Islands Make a list of the Scottish Islands. Why not write your list in alphabetical order for an extra challenge?	Scots' Language Create your own Scottish dictionary.	Scots' Language Conduct a survey to find out what your family and friend's favourite Scottish words are. Create a graph/table or chart to record your findings.
Scottish Wildlife Research a Scottish animal and create a factfile to show your findings. Remember to include a labelled diagram of your chosen animal.	Scottish Games Speak to a family member about a traditional game they played when they were younger. Write instructions on how to play the game.	Scottish Tourism Create a leaflet or a poster to encourage people to visit a Scottish place of interest.	Scottish Food Find a recipe for a Scottish treat (e.g. tablet, shortbread, macaroon etc.) Why not have a go at baking your treat? Remember to ask an adult for help.
Tartan Research what tartan is and design a tartan for your family name or you could create a tartan for Sandwood Primary.	Scottish Song/Poem Learn and perform a Scottish song or poem.	Scottish Myths Read some of Scotland's Myths and Legends and create your own mythical creature. Write a character description for your creature.
