Reading - In Class Thistle we read every day. We read a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts. We focus on our reading comprehension skills through our levelled reading books and practise our common words. We enjoy class story time at the end of each day.

Listening and Talking - We focus on our talking and listening skills continually throughout the day. We start the term, reminding ourselves of our 'Good listening skills' and 'good manners' and are also developing our ability to use restorative conversations to work out any problems.

Writing - We will be covering a range of different genres linked to our topic work including characterisation, recount and report. We will also have regular short handwriting sessions to help improve letter formation and write weekly news.

Spelling - We do spelling practice every day. Much of the time, we enjoy active and sensory spelling in a variety of different ways.



We are beginning the term with a unit of work on place value, counting and numerals. We will be using lots of practical resources to help us develop and secure our understanding.

In maths we will also be enjoying work on Time.

On our return to school, we will be revisiting our School Values.

As part of daily routine in class, we focus on emotions and ways that we can express them appropriately.



PE - our indoor PE day this term will be on a Tuesday.



Each Monday, children will bring home a new reading book for the week. The aim is that children should read, or be read to, at home 3 times per week.

Common words, phonic sound cards or spelling words relevant to individual pupil need will also be sent home. These should be practised/completed if your child is happy to do so.



Social Studies/Science/Technology - our focus is 'Dinosaurs.'

Expressive Arts Much of our art, music, PE and drama will be cross-curricular, linked to our topic.

RME - This term we will be learning about Harvest Stories and Customs.

Outdoor Learning We will regularly be taking our learning across the curriculum outdoors.

Digital Literacy - We will be learning about using Word.
