Practise saying the poem out loud. Remember to use your best Scottish accent. I would love to hear this so don't forget to send me a voice note on Seesaw!

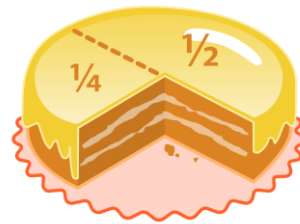
You could ask a family member to read it out to you and you can read it to them. Can you discuss what you think the Scottish words mean with your families?
