Let's go out into the garden or nearby park.

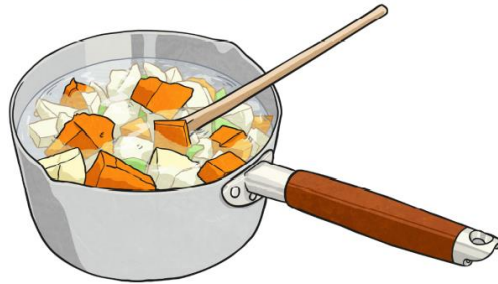
Walk round your garden or park twice.
